**MCRD SAN DIEGO YOUTH SPORTS TO HOST ON-BASE JUNIOR CHARGERS CAMP**

**WHAT:** MCRD San Diego Youth Sports, in partnership with the STAR/PAL (Sports Training, Academics, Recreation/Police Athletic League) and San Diego Chargers will host its second on-base Junior Chargers Training Camp. During the clinic, Chargers NFL payers along with volunteers from city and county law enforcement agencies will share their skills with children and teens (ages 7-14) of military families stationed throughout the San Diego area.

San Diego Chargers players are scheduled to attend the event where children and teens will learn football basics, how to live a healthy lifestyle through exercise, and the importance of setting academic goals. STAR/PAL is a non-profit organization promoting youth safety through crime and violence prevention education. They cultivate youth empowerment through various civic engagement activities throughout San Diego, offering youth programs such as tutoring, outdoor enrichment and mentoring in underserved communities.
