The Marine Corps Recruit Depot San Diego and the Western Recruiting Region Change of Command Ceremony will be held on Friday July 26 at 3 P.M. at the MCRD San Diego parade field. Brig. Gen. Daniel D. Yoo will relinquish command to Brig. Gen. James W. Bierman Jr.

Brig. Gen. Yoo's next assignment will be as the Assistant Division Commander of 1st Marine Division, Camp Pendleton, Calif.

Brig. Gen. Bierman is the former Military Secretary to the Commandant of the Marine Corps at Headquarters Marine Corps. As the commanding general of MCRD San Diego and the Western Recruiting Region, Bierman will oversee the recruiting and recruit training efforts of more than 4,000 military and civil service employees. Recruiting efforts cover the entire western half of the United States from the Mississippi river to the Pacific Ocean and includes Hawaii and Guam.
